SELF-GUIDED TOUR

1. OLD MAIN



Old Main is our flagship building and is the oldest on campus. Today, it holds our Admissions office and is also the site for Student Accounts, the President's Office, administrative offices, and the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science.

2. BLAIR HALL



Blair Hall is one of Eastern's original buildings and is home to the departments of Sociology, Anthropology, and Criminal Justice. Blair also houses the Office of International Students, the Study Abroad office, the Graduate School, and the Office of Inclusion and Academic Engagement.

3. NORTH QUAD



The North Quad features an open green grounds and gardens surrounded by academic buildings and residence halls. Nearby is the Student Services Building, which holds the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, as well as Campus Technology Support.

4. PEMBERTON HALL



Pemberton Hall opened in 1909 as the first women's residence hall in the state of Illinois. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is regarded for its architectural beauty.

5. HONORS COLLEGE



The Sandra and Jack Pine Honors College helps strong students excel by providing exceptional Honors classes; service and extracurricular opportunities; and support for undergraduate research and study abroad.

6. PHYSICAL SCIENCE BUILDING



The Physical Science Building is home to the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Psychology, Engineering and Geology/Geography.

7. MCAFEE GYM



Originally used as athletics facilities, the building now houses the Academic Success Center, which includes Academic Advising, Student Disability Services, Testing, and TRiO.

8. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. UNIVERSITY UNION



The MLK Union houses the Food Court, Java Beanery and Bakery, the University Bookstore and EIU Bowling Lanes. You'll also find the offices of Housing & Dining, Student Life, New Student Programs, University Board and Civic Engagement and Volunteerism.

9. DOUDNA FINE ARTS CENTER



The Doudna Fine Arts Center is a magnificent facility designed to showcase the Arts. Doudna has become a performance and teaching complex for the Departments of Art & Design, Music, and Theatre Arts. Our students perform here and proudly display their work throughout the corridors, as well as in the nearby Tarble Arts Center and Burl Ives Studio Hall. The building also features a digital recording studio, soundproof practice rooms, and labs for painting, costume design, metalsmithing, and sculpture.

10. BOOTH LIBRARY



Booth Library is the academic heart of Eastern and the geographic center of campus. Known throughout the region for its beautiful cathedral style entryway, it contains nearly 2 million books and countless periodicals, and it's a great place for students to check out movies, music, and TV shows for free. There are also educational resources for teachers and over 30,000 children's books in the Ballenger Teachers Center.

11. LIFE SCIENCE BUILDING



The Life Science Building is the home of Biological Sciences, Environmental Biology, and over a dozen pre-health professions, including pre-dentistry, pre-medicine, pre-nursing, and pre-vet programs.

12. COLEMAN HALL



One of the most highly trafficked buildings on campus, nearly every student will take at least one class here. It houses the Departments of History, English, World Languages, Economics, Philosophy, and Political Science.

13. LUMPKIN & KLEHM HALLS



Lumpkin Hall houses the Lumpkin School of Business & Technology with collaborative and interactive spaces, computer labs and state-of-the-art instructional technology, such as the Securities Analysis Center. Business majors include Accounting, Finance, Management, Business Analytics & Information Systems, and Marketing. Nearby Klehm Hall is the site for the College of Health and Human Services and the School of Technology.

14. BUZZARD HALL



Buzzard Hall is home to the College of Education, the Departments of Journalism and Communication Studies, and the School of Extended Learning. Here you can also find the campus newspaper The Daily Eastern News, our radio station Hit-Mix 88.9, and our Student Emmy Award-winning WEIU-TV News Watch.

15. HUMAN SERVICES BUILDING



In the Human Services Building, professional staff in the Medical and Counseling Clinics support our students' physical and emotional health and well-being, ensuring they are happy and healthy while they learn and grow. Our Career Services Office is one of EIU's most valuable resources, assisting students with professional development and job placement after graduation. Also housed here is one of our nationally known academic departments, Communication Disorders and Sciences.

16. ANDREWS HALL



Andrews Hall is one of 11 residence halls located on campus. Andrews is an all-female, nine-story building with laundry facilities on each floor. For additional residence hall information, visit: eiu.edu/housing.

17. STEVENSON HALL



Stevenson Hall is a ten-story, mixed-gender facility with suite-style rooms, common living areas, and private bathrooms. It's available to juniors, seniors, transfer students, and students 21 years or older. For additional residence hall information, visit: eiu.edu/housing.

18. STUDENT RECREATION CENTER



The Student Recreation Center provides a safe and enjoyable environment to get or stay fit. It features group fitness classes, racquetball courts, a disc golf course, jogging trail, lighted outdoor courts and fields, and the indoor Ray Padovan Pool.

19. LOUIS M. GRADO TEXTBOOK RENTAL BUILDING



A unique cost-saving feature at Eastern is our textbook rental service. This means an average savings of \$900 per year compared to most universities, which require students to buy textbooks.

20. GREEK COURT



Greek Court is EIU's on-campus fraternity and sorority housing complex. The Greek community at Eastern consists of nearly 30 chapters, three honor societies and over a thousand undergraduate members.

21. NINTH STREET HALL



This building houses the Gail & Richard Lumpkin School of Nursing. EIU offers a flexible, online registered nurse (RN) to bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) program for working nurses, as well as a four-year bachelor of science program in Nursing.
